Remembering Father Tom Crowley (June 1950- March 2017)

We were all shocked and saddened to learn last Wednesday (March 29), that our former and beloved pastor at OLHOC (from 2004-2011), Fr. Tom Crowley had died. We all knew that Fr. Crowley had been sick as we kept praying for his healing at our daily and Sunday Masses for the last few weeks. But he had been seriously ill before and then he had fully recovered. We knew that he had a strong will to recover and we expected him to surmount his recent illness. He had been on our parish prayer list for a long time. We will continue praying for him. We will pray for the repose of his soul. May his soul be at peace. May God, all-merciful, say: "Welcome my faithful servant!"

On the very day Fr. Crowley passed away, we were able to offer a Mass for the repose of his soul. We had already planned a Mass at 8 pm on March 29 on the occasion of the extraordinary visit of the International Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima, in this year of the 100th anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady to three little children in Portugal. Thanks to technology, we could let most of our parishioners know of the intention of this special Mass. Many of you were there. The church was packed with close to 400 people. There was much sadness as we remembered Fr. Crowley and his seven years as our pastor at OLHOC. But there was also a sense of closure and peace, as we knew how much he had suffered through a series of illnesses. The time had come for God to call back his faithful servant. Fr. Crowley had given 40 years of his life to Christ, serving him as a priest from 1976-2017. Just one year ago, Fr. Crowley was honored by Cardinal Wuerl for having served the Archdiocese of Washington for 40 full years as a priest! Fr. Crowley had been ordained at the young age of 26. He had literally given his whole life to Christ and the Church.

On Sunday, March 19 (just a short time ago...), I invited Deacon Bill and his wife Rhonda to come with me and visit Fr. Crowley. I had just learned that he had been hospitalized. This was the last time we would see Fr. Crowley. We spent over half an hour with him. His mind was sharp and witty as ever. As we were leaving, I asked Father if he had any message for OLHOC parishioners. His answer was simple: "Give them all my love and thanks for their prayers!" Our next question was would he welcome visits from some parishioners? His answer was much shorter: "No!" We all knew that Fr. Crowley was a very private person and that even when he fell ill while being our pastor at OLHOC, he chose not to share information about his health. We also knew how much he loved our parish and our parishioners! We will all have more opportunities to share our fond memories of Fr. Crowley. You are all invited to continue to pray for the repose of the soul of Fr. Crowley. We will have two other Memorial Masses for him: 10 am Mass on Palm Sunday and 7 pm Mass on Holy
