The Pews Are Coming! The Pews Are Coming!

As I am writing this column (always on Tuesday morning, before the printing deadline), I would like to share with you some excitement that took place early this morning around 7:00 am: a large truck stopped in the middle of the circle in front of our church. It had come all the way from Lancaster, Pennsylvania! We had been waiting for that truck for many weeks! It contained the pews that had been manufactured by "New Holland" in Dutch Pennsylvania (land of the Amish)! We had to move our regular daily Mass from the Blessed Sacrament Chapel to the Summer Church. We also had to move our Tuesday Scripture Prayer Group (beginning at 10 am) from the Narthex to our new "Summer Narthex" (aka Office Entrance). All this, so that we could let the crew from "New Holland" bring all the pews inside the Church. At the end of the Mass, some parishioners asked me whether they could go and see the new pews. My response was: "No!"

Can't you wait until the weekend of **August 19/20** when we move our Masses back to the renovated Church? Wouldn't you prefer to see the totality of the ongoing renovation, as opposed to parts of it? We also do not want to interfere with the work of the New Holland crew. We would, however, like to take this opportunity to express our appreciation for the feedback we have received on the current setup in the Summer Church. This feedback, together with what we received through the whole process or preparation of the Phase 1 of our Capital Campaign, has been invaluable as it will help us to continue to have at OLHOC a place of worship that is welcoming, prayerful, joyful, and above all, spiritual!

In consultation with our Parish Council and our Liturgy Planning Committee, we are also preparing to have a **Re-dedication** of our renovated church at the 11:30 am Mass on **Sunday, September 10**. We have invited Bishop Knestout to join us for this event. The Bishop already blessed our outdoor Mary Statue and our large inside Crucifix. He has been personally involved in reviewing our parish renovation proposals from the very beginning of our capital campaign. Why **Sunday, September 10**? It has been our annual tradition to celebrate the anniversary of the establishment of our parish on the Sunday prior to September 15; Cardinal Hickey did so on September 15, 1980! This September, we will turn 37 years young! It has also been our tradition to combine that anniversary celebration with our annual picnic, which we will hold this year after the 11:30 am Mass of Re-dedication! The Parish Council has also suggested that we use the opportunity of this September 10 picnic to have a **display of ongoing activities** at our parish and each of our committees/organizations are being invited to have a simple display (e.g., Preschool, Knights of Columbus, Community Outreach, CCD, RCIA, Marian Group, Music Ministry, Altar Guild, Scripture Prayer Group, Lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist serving the Homebound, etc.).
