

Our Lady of Fatima is Coming March 29:
Praying for Peace and Conversion!

Our Lady of Fatima is coming on Wednesday to OLHOC. We are blessed and honored to have the visit of the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima. In this centennial year of celebrating the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima, this famous and unique statue is traveling throughout the U.S. and we are one of the three parishes chosen within the entire Archdiocese of Washington. This unique tour of our country is a **nationwide call to prayer and penance for peace in our nation and conversion of hearts!**

Many of you may recall that exactly three years ago (Friday, April 4, 2014), we welcomed the International Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima at OLHOC for the first time. Her first visit led to an outpouring of grace not only on those who participated in the evening outdoor procession and night-long prayers, but also on our entire parish. Our Lady of Fatima, through her statue, is still leading to miracles. Her **Pilgrim Statue** has been seen shedding tears many times...and has brought many graces throughout the world. It was sculpted in 1947 according to the description of Sister Lucia, one of the three children who saw Mary six times between May 13 and October 13, 1917. In 1951, Pope Pius XII said: " In 1946, we crowned Our Lady of Fatima as Queen of the World and the next year, through Her Pilgrim Statue, she set forth as though to claim her dominion, and the favors she performs along the way are such that we can hardly believe what we are seeing with our eyes."

You are all invited to **come and see Our Lady of Fatima on Wednesday, March 29! Come and participate in this nationwide prayer for peace and conversion!** Many countries of the world are facing violence and war! The whole world is in need of prayer for **peace and conversion!** The message of Fatima one-hundred years ago is as valid today as it was in 1917 when the whole world was experiencing the worst-ever war, **the first World War**, and when communism was taking hold in Russia! One of the first messages of Our Lady of Fatima was :"**Say the Rosary every day in order to obtain peace for the whole world and the end of war.**" (First Apparition on May 13, 1917).

If you have never attended a candlelight procession, this is your chance. Bring your family and friends! The outdoor **Candlelight Procession of Our Lady of Fatima** will begin at 7 pm, this Wednesday, March 29. If you were unable to attend our Penance Service last week, you will have ample opportunity to **reconcile with God!** We will have **confessions** from 5 pm to 7 pm, and again from 7:15 to 7:45 pm. If you have never attended our Wednesday evening Mass (began last Easter Season), this is your chance, too! We will have Mass at 8 pm (one hour later than our regular Wednesday evening Mass, because of the Procession and Rosary). The detailed schedule is shown on the next page of this bulletin.

As many of you experience an outpouring of the Holy Spirit during our well-attended Family Mission last week (over 200 people every evening, from Monday through Wednesday), I can assure you that this outpouring of the Holy Spirit will continue this week as we prepare for this extraordinary visit of the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima. **Our Lady is closely related to the Holy Spirit: She is His Spouse!**
