Receive The Holy Spirit !

“ **Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love!**” This was the prayer Fr. Moriarty used every day before teaching us at St. John XXIII Seminary in Boston! It is a most powerful prayer. Not surprisingly, it is sung before the proclamation of the Gospel at every Mass on this great **Solemnity of Pentecost** we are celebrating today! We are all invited to ask the Holy Spirit to enter our hearts and to fill them with the **fire of the love of God!** This sums up the long **Sequence** which is read or sung at every Pentecost Mass and begins with those words: **Come, Holy Spirit, Come!**

I invite all of you to meditate on this **prayer to the Holy Spirit!** I am confident that you will find one or two words that will touch your own hearts. As I am writing this column, I chose to read the whole Pentecost Sequence slowly, asking the Holy Spirit to guide my own reflection. Here are the words that touched me: *“Come, Father of the Poor...heal our wounds, our strength renew...Wash the stains of guilt away...Bend the stubborn heart and will...guide the steps that go astray...On the faithful, who adore and confess you...give them your salvation, give them joys that never end.. Alleluia!”*

These words above reminded me of a recent experience I had while visiting inmates at the Charles County Detention Center. As you know, it is a grace to be able to visit those in jail and I go there about once a month. On one of these visits, I was asked by one inmate, (whom I will call ‘Peter’ to protect his anonymity) to visit one of his friends (I will call ‘Paul’ etc.). I had visited Peter regularly and it was the second time that he had asked me to help someone else. When I met Paul, I had no idea who he was or why he wanted to see me. After a long conversation with him, it became clear that he was seeking the **truth** and wanted to know **how to be saved**. We spent lots of time reading the Bible together. I also found out that Paul had never been baptized although several people in his family were Catholics (but not practicing their faith). To make a long story short... Paul eventually asked me to **baptize him!** I gave him an abbreviated Catechesis for Adults wishing to enter the Catholic Church. I will never forget the day I baptized and confirmed him and I will never forget the **joy** that Paul radiated on that day. This was truly the **Holy Spirit** at work: Baptism with Water and Confirmation with Chrism Oil and Imposition of Hands!

As said in the Pentecost Sequence, the Holy Spirit was truly healing Paul’s **wounds** , **washing the stains of his guilt away, guiding his steps that had gone astray...and giving him salvation...and joys that never end!** What also made that experience very special is the impact Paul’s **conversion** had on Peter. Later on, when I told Peter that had it not been for his seeking help for Paul, Paul may have never been baptized and encountered the power of the **Holy Spirit** – this was a seed that Peter had planted! For many of us, unlike Peter, we may never know the impact of the seeds we are
