Jonah's Miracle...Nave Renovation... and Going to Fatima!

Lots of excitement last week and this week! Last Friday morning at 11:30 am, a **true miracle** happened in our Summer Church (a.k.a. Social Hall) when over 75 of our children and youth performed a remarkable musical representation of **Jonah!** Another 40 volunteers, including youth, were also involved in the preparation of this performance that took place after only four mornings of practice during what we have referred to as our Vacation Bible School. I was able to observe only the first two practices on Monday and Tuesday morning, but I knew already that something special was happening. And it did so on Friday morning and I call it: **Jonah's Miracle!** Our children and youth will never forget the amazing story of the Book of Jonah. Jonah's lessons are multiple and I encourage you all to open your Bible this week and read again Jonah's journey as he tried to avoid God's command by fleeing from Nineveh where God was sending him.

To reinforce the key lessons from the Book of Jonah, four of them were shown on the screen in the Summer Narthex (a.k.a. lobby area near the office and Social Hall) in simple words: 1. We can be guilty of the **same sins** Jonah was guilty of! 2. **God is merciful!** 3. **Listen** for God's call and **do not** run from it! 4. We **cannot** run from **responsibility!** This was visible to parents, friends, and all that were not necessarily involved in the morning practices. I am confident that every child and youth involved in the play performance will remember at least one lesson. In parallel, Fr. Santiago and I were listening to a large number of confessions of our children/youth from 10 to about 11:30 am every morning (except the first day): Jonah's story definitely helped in the individual preparation for these confessions that took place in our **summer confessional** (a.k.a. Cry Room, which by coincidence has Jonah's whale painted on the wall as part of a much earlier decoration of the entire Cry Room by talented volunteer parishioners). Our youth could literally see Jonah's whale while confessing their sins. Thanks go to all the over 100 participants and their families for such a beautiful expression of **community** and **joy!** You can watch the video of this Jonah's miracle on YouTube! Special thanks also go to our DRE and our Music Director who single-handedly led the main practices and the final performance.

This week saw another type of excitement. First, we are coming close to the end of **Phase I** of our Capital Campaign. We can finally see the **light at the end of the tunnel!** After several weeks of intense activities, the **renovation** of the entire **Nave of our Church** is almost completed! We need a few final touches and **yes**, we are on schedule to reopen our main church on Saturday afternoon for 4 pm confessions and 5 pm Mass on **August 19!** Our last Mass in the Summer Church will be at 7 pm on the evening of the **Assumption of Our Lady** on Tuesday, **August 15** (a Holy Day of Obligation). Fr. Santiago will be the main celebrant on that day (also at 9 am and noon Masses), as I will be with 40 pilgrims from Waldorf celebrating the Assumption at 11:15 am (5:15 am Waldorf time) in Aire-sur-la-Lys at the most northern part of France, also the city of the birth of Fr. Narcisse Martin in 1845, who as many of you know was one of the main evangelizers in Waldorf for 29 consecutive years (1894-1923) , and is one of the major inspirations of my own priesthood (more to say about him after our return late on August 16).
