Celebrating Our Lady of Fatima with Bishop Dorsonville:

At OLHOC Beginning 5 PM Sunday, October 15

Do you remember Saturday, May 13, 2017? It is only five months ago...seems like a long time has passed! On that day we launched at OLHOC the county-wide initiative to honor Our Lady of Fatima on the 100th anniversary of each of the apparitions. Our church was packed with 400 people and this augured well for the following monthly events. We can all be grateful to the OLHOC Marian Group, the 20 people meeting regularly after the 9 am Mass on Saturdays (note: everyone is welcome to join the discussion). Not only did they organize the May 13 event, but they also assisted the other five parishes responsible for the other events. As an example, they made our own statue of Our Lady of Fatima available to the other parishes, and also publicized all the events. As a result, our parish had many parishioners attending all the monthly events. In addition, we had our own pilgrimage to Fatima (beginning August 6) with 40 pilgrims from the Waldorf area, which brought many fruits. We returned from Fatima to Waldorf, just in time to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the Fourth Apparition on Saturday, August 19, the only apparition that did not take place on the 13th of the month.

We are now coming close to the end of this Extraordinary Centennial Year of Fatima. The last miracle took place on October 13, 1917, and next month on Friday, October 13, we will be at Sacred Heart, La Plata. For our own parish, however, October 13 will not be the end of the 100th anniversary celebration. October is also the month of Mary, the month of Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7), and so on.

This year, the Parish Council is fully supporting a major celebration in October focusing on Our Lady of Fatima. We are honored that **Bishop Dorsonville** has accepted our invitation to come **for such celebration with us** on **Sunday, October 15**. He will meet with parishioners at **5 pm**. We will then have a **Living Rosary**, an **outdoor Eucharistic and Marian Procession**, a **bilingual Mass** at **7 pm**, followed by **music and fellowship** in the Social Hall. You are all invited to come to this **feast!** We also plan on that day to consecrate our entire parish to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. We will write more about this shortly. Stay tuned!

Two weeks ago, I wrote a column about the **five messages of Fatima: P.R.A.R.S** (see weekly bulletin of Sept. 10). Several of you have questioned my way of pronouncing this acronym: **pra-ears** or better, **prayers** ! When I chose the five messages: Peace, Rosary, Adoration, Reconciliation, and Sacrifice, I was not trying to find a simple way to memorize them. In hindsight however, it is clear that every message from Fatima has to do with **prayer!** I hope that you can remember those five words and choose which one of these messages you would like to apply to your own spiritual life: Pray for peace daily? Pray the Rosary daily? Pray in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament one hour a week? Go to Reconciliation once a month and begin the monthly Devotion of the First Five Saturdays? Offer your sufferings daily as a sacrifice for God?

May Our Lady of Fatima inspire your **pra-ear (prayer) life** and may she protect you and your families! May she lead all of us to Jesus!
