## End of Times: 11:00 PM, Tuesday, November 28?

Is the end of times near? Is the end of times coming this week at **11:00 PM, Tuesday, November 28?** In my homily last weekend, I invited everyone to reflect on the timing of the End of Times. From the parable of the 10 virgins (Matthew 25), Jesus is very clear—we need to stay awake, to stay vigilant, to stay ready as we do not know neither the day nor the hour when Jesus will come again (Matthew 25:13). Does it matter that it happens in three hours from now, or three days from now, or three years from now? If Jesus were to announce today the exact hour and day of the end of times, would we behave differently? Would we make a change in our lives? Imagine, as you are reading this weekly bulletin on Sunday morning, Nov. 26, that **Jesus is coming to sit next to you and tell you very clearly that the end of times will happen at 11:00 pm this Tuesday, November 28!** This gives you **three days to change your life and be ready to welcome Jesus as He returns for good on earth.** How do you **prepare in three days?** How would you spend those three final days of your life on earth?

Yes, how do you plan to spend the next three days, the final three days? I asked that question from several of you, and got insightful answers! Someone said that she would fly to Alabama to see her sister that she had not seen for years. Another, a young student, said “I definitely would not go back to school.” Another said “I would pray for the conversion of all my family members and friends so that we can all be reunited in **Heaven!**” The question is: what would **you** do?

Three days is a rather short time. But one can still do many, many things in those three final days. I love my entire family. I love to travel. I would take the time to fly around the world and get together with my extended family in California, Japan, France, Florida, and Puerto Rico. Or I would meet my entire extended family in one single place, like in Hawaii, where we could all enjoy being together once more at the beach, enjoy the waves, have wonderful meals together with great conversations; and then spend the last day of our lives together, going to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, attending Mass, **being One in Christ** through receiving the **Eucharist**, praying together in silence in front of the Blessed Sacrament inside a beautiful Catholic Church, looking at Jesus already fully present in the Blessed Sacrament and awaiting peacefully **His second and final coming**, awaiting for Him to take us all together with **Him into heaven for ever and ever!**

What will you do in the next three days? It depends where you are right now in **your own relationship with God.** It depends whether you still have a major sin on your conscience that you have not yet been able to **ask for God’s forgiveness!** It depends on the timing of **your last confession.** If it were many years ago, the **top priority** is to return to the **great sacrament right away!** Whether you want to reach out to someone you have not yet forgiven, or whether you want to travel and spend quality time with someone very dear to you that you have not seen for a long time, I have one single recommendation for everyone, including Fr. Santiago, Deacon Rich, Deacon Bill, and myself: **Go immediately to the Sacrament of Reconciliation!**

We have planned an **Advent Penance Service** for all of you on **Tuesday, November 28 at 7 pm!!** You are all invited to attend, including your children and all your friends! We will have

And even if the end of times were to be delayed beyond 11 pm on Nov. 28, 2017, you would have reached **peace and happiness in Christ,** and would be **ready to enter into this beautiful Season of Advent,** anticipating the joy of the First Coming of Jesus at Christmas!!

I pray that those of you who have begun the **33 days of total Consecration to Jesus through Mary** will continue and be ready for the amazing total Consecration on **December 8, our National Feast of the Immaculate Conception!!** May God guide all of us to prepare for a great **Confession on Tuesday, November 28!!** May God help all of us to be ready when **His Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ** will come back on the great day of the end of time!
